## Goals

- Data Goal: To improve the quality of data products
- Research Goal: To actively participate in quantitative economic analysis of pressing global concern in the areas of: Trade and Development and Global Environmental Issues
- *Model Goal*: To promote further development of GTAP-based models
- Education Goal: To expand and improve global economic analysis education worldwide
- Staffing Goal: To actively seek and encourage talented staff and graduate students

## Data Goal: Highlights

- GTAP 7 Data Base released to the public in Nov 2008
  - 2004 data and 113 regions
  - Services trade and energy data significantly improved
  - Protection, trade, domestic support, agricultural export subsidies, export taxes on textiles and wearing apparel
- Other data activities
  - GTAP Africa Data Base
  - TASTE
- Data Base documentation
- Issues reporting to board and public

# Data Goal: Progress and Challenges

- Work on the GTAP Data Base is currently proceeding along three lines:
  - Documentation of the GTAP 7 Data Base
  - Construction of the GTAP 7.1 Data Base: 27 EU I-O tables and revised cotton support estimates
  - Development of a feasible agenda for v8 given data, staffing and time constraints
    - Two of the key challenges in v7 were: the energy data and ensuring high quality regional I-O data
    - In v8: Taxes, Domestic Margins and I-O Table Processing
    - Protection data: To continue to offer the GTAP community state-of-the-art protection data

## **Strategies**

- Last year the Center developed a proposed agenda for improvements to the GTAP Data Base to be implemented in versions 8 through 10
- This agenda is continuously being revised and updated
  - Levent Aydin will be joining us July to work on energy.
  - Angel Aguiar will work on improving the regional I-O data, including implementing the peer review system.
  - Nico van Leeuwen will be visiting for 6 months to assist with taxes, and domestic margins and I-O table processing
  - The US ITC is currently assisting with improvements to the skills splits for v8.
  - The protection data and a proposal for further improvements to TASTE will be discussed today.

# Research Goal and Model: Trade and Development

#### • Highlights:

- Dynamic GTAP book has been sent to the publisher
- Demand for Poverty module has been increasing

#### Challenges:

- Increasing use of GDyn Model amongst the network
- Developing a set of country data bases for the poverty module

#### Strategy:

- Increasing use of Dynamic Model by staff and grads, and courses
- Technical paper on methodology to develop a poverty module

# Research and Model Goal: Energy and the Environment

#### • Highlights:

- New book on global land use and climate policy published
- Research on land use issues and biofuels has garnered high visibility

#### Challenges:

- Establish the Center as a global research leader in land use and biofuels research
- Continue efforts in model development

#### • Strategy:

- Publication strategy in land use and biofuels
- Continue with plans for further development of GTAP-E and GDyn-E Models

## **Education Goal**

#### Highlights:

- Continued high demand for courses and increasing interest by potential hosts
- Successful first attempt at live web-based learning session

#### Challenges:

- Education of users who are unable to come to the GTAP Short Courses
- Staff development

#### Strategy:

- Focus is currently on training internal staff members
- To offer more live forums on data issues to assist in network building and increasing credibility
- Offer 'webinars' on specialized topics

# Staffing and Collaboration Goal

#### Background:

- Levent Aydin is joining us in July
- Angel Aguiar will become full time later this year
- Nico van Leeuwen will be visiting for 6 months to assist with taxes, and domestic margins and I-O table processing
- Terrie Walmsley to work for GTAP from Australia
- We are interested in opportunities to fostering more collaboration with institutions around the world

#### Challenge:

- Our ability to continue to attract and retain quality staff
- How the Center should be structured given that we want to foster collaboration and staff are choosing to live elsewhere

## Global Purdue

- Strategically seek growth opportunities by placing people within supportive team environments in key regions, where they can:
  - support and encourage regional activities through courses, conferences, etc. while interacting with board and network members
  - undertake data and research projects jointly with board and network members that feed back to the core GTAP mission
- Tactically, the Center needs to become more open (flexible) to having employees working from a remote location to help in retaining good people
