GTAP Research Fellows 2009-2012

- Individuals are awarded the GTAP Research Fellow distinction in recognition of their significant contribution to the development of GTAP through:
 - contributions to the GTAP Data Base
 - contributions to the development of GTAP models and software,
 - outstanding research using the GTAP Data Base and/or models, or
 - contributions in advancing the use of GTAP and broadening the GTAP network.

GTAP Research Fellows 2009-2012

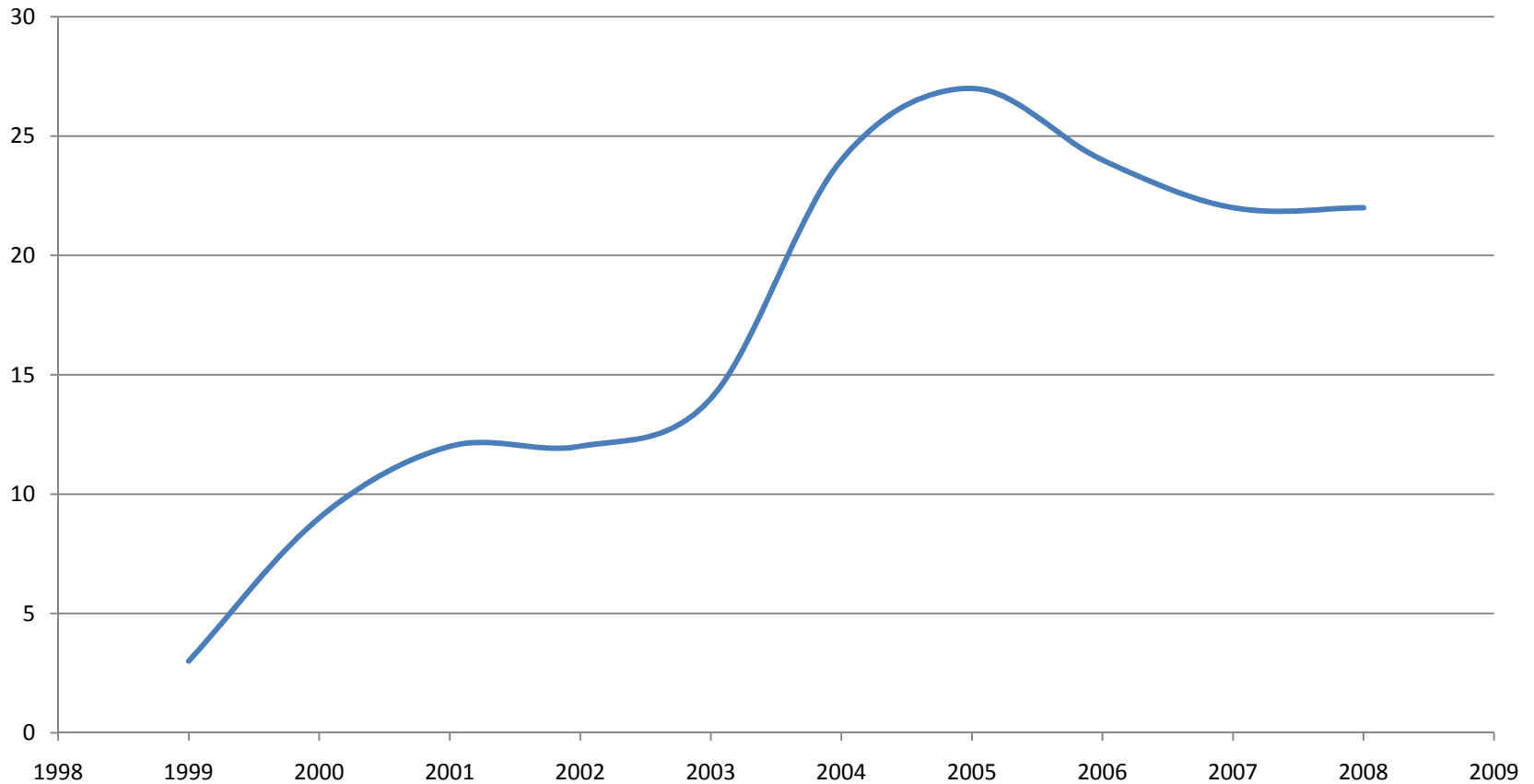
- Research Fellows are awarded a 3-year term.
- Starting in 2005, a GTAP Research Fellows Committee was formed.
- The committee selects candidates from nominations made to it by the board and GTAP Staff.
- Awards are made by the board on the basis of the committee's recommendation.

GTAP Research Fellows 2009-2012

- Discussions started under the chair of Patrick Jomini about the « **inflation** » of RFs in the past years. 
- Thinking about it in “**steady-state**”, the RF committee thinks that it doesn’t have to limit its ability to recognize and motivate significant contributors.
