General Features of Standard Migration Model

- Full employment.
- Bilateral movement of labour.
- Domestic and foreign workers are perfect substitutes.
- Key drivers:
 - Remittances
 - Real factor prices (Pfactreal)

Unemployment Migration Extension

• Unemployment of unskilled labour in exporting regions.

Exogenous Migration Extension

 Impact of migrants between MENA and other regions due to political instability.

Liberalization in the context of the GATS WTO negotiations.

• Developing countries in particular African countries want to take advantage of the services liberalization in the context of the WTO negotiations.

Endogenous Migration Extension

- Impact of taxing income of skilled labour in exporting country.
- Skilled labour forced to move due the reduction to their real income.
