## Tenth Anniversary Conference on Global Economic Analysis


- 131 total presentations:
  - 4 plenary papers and one panel
  - 48 organized presentations (14 sessions)
  - 83 selected paper presentations (28 sessions)
- About 200 registered participants as follows:
  - 1/3 N. America
  - 1/3 Europe
  - 1/3 LAm/Asia/Africa/Oceania

### Historical Perspective on Submissions and Participants

- Total number of presentations:
  - Steady over past 4 years
  - Share of organized sessions is larger this year due to active program committee
- Total number of participants:
  - Appears fairly steady: comparable to the previous two years (more in DC/2004 – about 250, less previously)
  - Composition is heavily influenced by location of conference: This should be borne in mind in deciding on future locations.

#### **Future Conferences**

- 2008: Helsinki (Final)
- 2009: Santiago, Chile (Final)
- 2010: Asia? (Proposals to be submitted by December 2007)
  - Japan: NIES has expressed an interest in hosting, but needs strong support from local GTAP community
  - IDE has expressed an interest in hosting a conference in Southeast Asia – possibly Bangkok
  - Others in Bangkok with an interest: UN-ESCAP, local ADB office, and various Thai organizations
- 2011: Venice: FEEM has expressed an interest for the past few years. Conference would need to be in July, after university term is complete.
