

GTAP Finances and Staffing

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Executive Summary

- Running a surplus of \$28K this year
 - High course revenue from 3 courses helped recover salaries
 - But high costs due to: board meeting; recruitment costs; and Data Base Documentation printing and delivery
- Data Sales Still strong and repeat business is very good!
- Funding obtained for additional staff Member from Special Africa project funded by European Commission and BNPP/ World Bank
- 3 New Hires at the Center
 - Data Base manager; Program manager; and Environmental Economist
 - Expect releases to be delayed next year.
- New measures to improve financial situation, including consortium agreements and data base documentation.
- Next year a deficit, but if data base cycle can be limited to 3 years financial situation is more positive over long run.

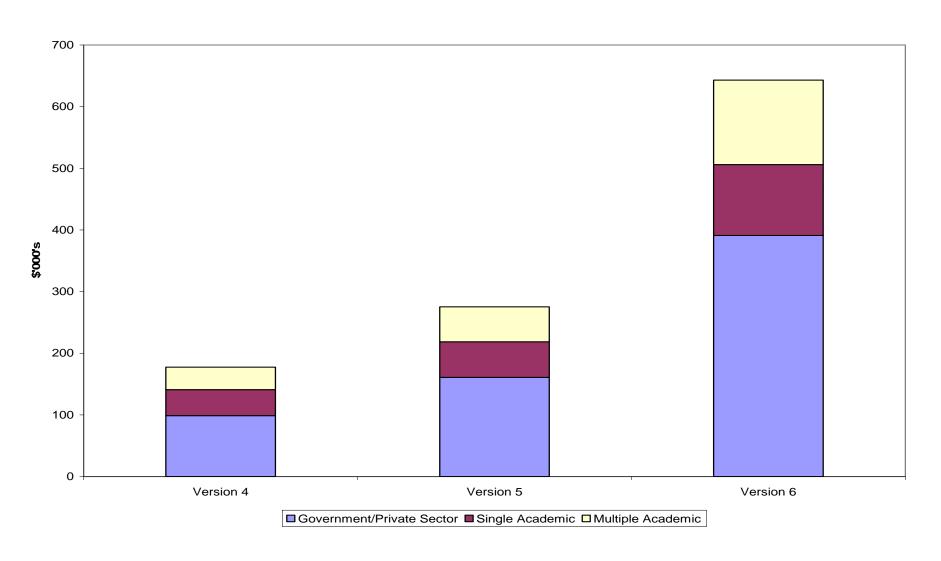

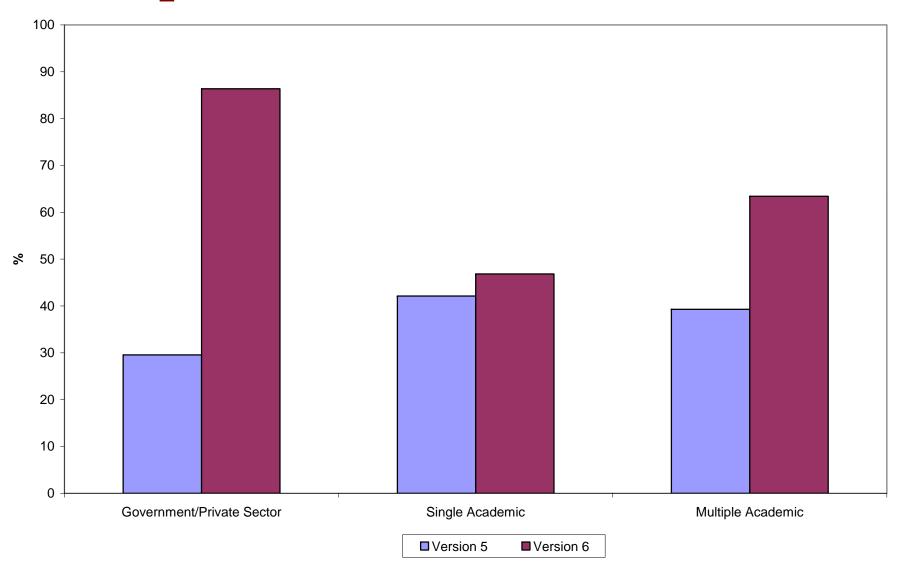
FY: April 1, 2006 to March 31, 2007

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Data Base Sales for v6 very high!



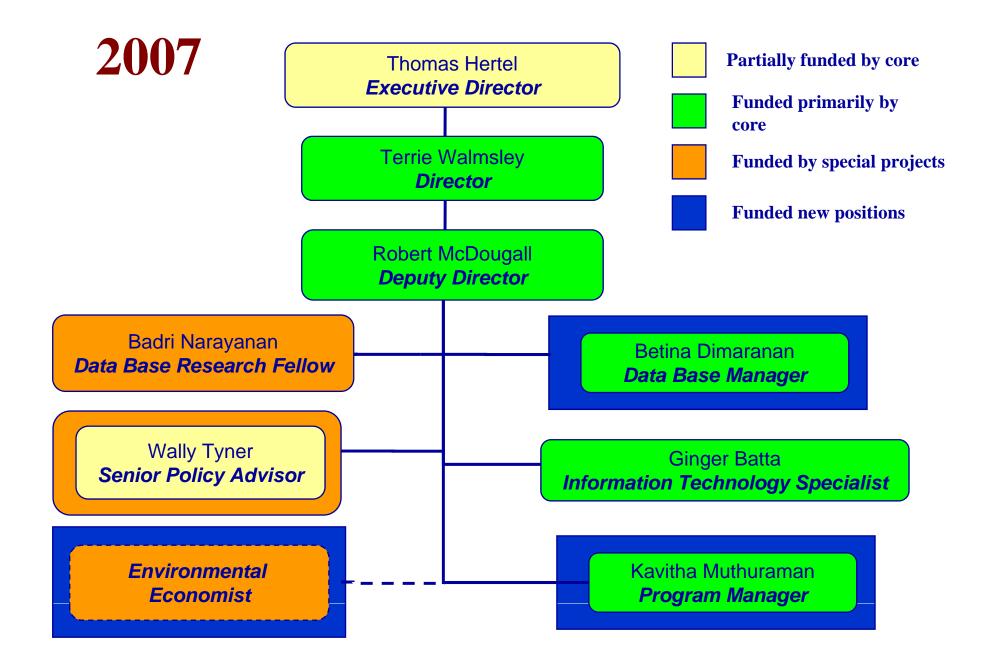
Repeat Business is on the Rise!

- Description of role

 - Looking for someone with an advanced degree plus experience with large datasets.
- Current Status
 - Funding available
 - Betina leaves June 30

New Appointments: Program Manager

- Description of role
 - This person will manage the GTAP Programs, oversee the GTAP finances, communicate with board and network members and oversee marketing efforts.
 - Funded from core data
- Current Status
 - Advertising position
 - New person required end of July, Kavitha departs in fall

New Appointments: Environmental Economist

Description of role

- This person will assist with current projects and build their own research agenda in Environmental Economics using the GTAP framework.
- Funds secured from special projects

Current Status

- March-May 2006, Interviewed 3 candidates for Research Faculty Position
- Near term: Hiring a post-doc to focus on immediate needs.
- Future: Research Faculty Position not ruled out.

Transition Plan

- Involving Badri in basic build activities until Betina's replacement is hired.
- Involving other staff on the Africa project in the meantime (e.g., Nelson)
- Hiring her replacement as soon as possible
 hopefully having someone here August 1
- Prerelease 3 expected in October
