Domestic Support: European Union

The purpose of this chapter is to explain how to take the Total support estimates for the EU25 which can be downloaded from OECD's web site www.oecd.org/dataoecd/12/22/36998707.xls (accessed January 2007) and dis-aggregate the EU25's Producer Support Estimated (PSE) into the 25 individual member countries for the year 2004. For each of the 25 member countries the PSE are further dis-aggregated into 12 primary agricultural commodities in accordance with GTAP databases commodity aggregation.

First of all the EU25 Total Support Estimate for the year 2004, found in the OECD database, are adjusted so that provisional estimates for crop payments found in the 2004 PSE tables are updated with actual payments, which have been taken from the EAGGF-GUARANTEE – EXERCICIE 2005 http://ec.europa.eu/agriculture/fin/finrep05/workdoc_en.pdf.

In Table 1 the OECD's total support estimate in million of €, heading B to H, are shown together with the updated estimate for the aggregate EU25, which have also been allocated (dis-aggregated) to the individual 25 member countries. The method used to dis-aggregate payments by member country is very simply done by looking at each payment listed and if possible find the corresponding payment in the EAGGF-GUARANTEE – EXERCICIE 2004 or 2005 where payments are specified by member country (EU budget item are shown in the Table). In the case of national payments, they have been disaggregated by member country using additional information about national support in each member country provided by the OECD. At the same time if payments are commodity-specific they allocated a reference to a corresponding GTAP commodity and if there is no reference, payments are allocated among the GTAP commodities using the share of the commodity in the value of production or the number of hectares in each member country following the method then used by the OECD at the EU25 aggregate level.

In Table 10.B.1 the total value of agricultural production is shown for each member country. These values of production (in producer prices) are taken from EUROSTAT's Economic Accounts for Agriculture, which are also disaggregated by GTAP commodity in the following Tables.

The support payments and values of production by GTAP commodity are shown in Tables 10.B.2 to 10.B.13. The support payments, which are classified by policy measures in the OECD indicators of support (sub-components B to H), are grouped within each commodity into four categories namely:

1. Output subsidies
2. Intermediate input subsidies
3. Land-based payments
4. Capital-based payments

The PSE support categories B to H are grouped into the four support measures using a standard formula applied to all regions. Under this formula, C and F2 payments, which encompass hectare and set aside premiums given to arable crops, are allocated under land-based payments while C and F2 payments for animal production are allocated under capital-based payments.

Chapter 10C explains further processing done within GTAP Data Base construction process. All the figures in these tables undergo some changes after this data is fed into it. The power of domestic support obtained after this procedure is used to find the GTAP value of payments in the initial V7 database by multiplying the power of the domestic support with the corresponding VOM value. Here after the percentage value shares of output subsidies, input subsidies, land and capital based payments are used to allocate the calculated GTAP value of payments to the appropriate tax wedges in the final V7 database.
